

Welcome to the Nepean Allotment Garden Association (NAGA)

Established in 1991, NAGA is one of Ottawa's largest community gardens, with about 250 plots and over 200 active gardeners. We're located at **230 Viewmount Drive, Ottawa, Ontario**. We are a **non-profit**, run entirely by volunteers. All plot fees go directly into **maintaining and improving the garden**.

We offer three types of plots: **annual** (tilled each spring), **perennial** (not tilled), and **raised beds**. Once you have a plot, you can renew it each year or switch to a different type if space is available.

Services & Amenities

- **Tool Shed:** Shared tools for all gardeners. Access code is in the newsletter. Please return tools promptly and keep the shed tidy.
- **Lockers:** Individual lockers available for rent
- **Compost:** Free delivery in spring.
- **Straw Bales:** Available for purchase in spring.
- **Water Taps:** Located throughout the garden. Bring your own hose or share with a neighbour. Hoses may be left at the tap at your own risk.
- **Porta-Potty:** On-site from May to October.
- **Social Events:** Seasonal cleanups, plant swaps, harvest swaps, and workshops.

Gardening Guidelines

- **Use your plot:** Abandoned or weed-covered plots will be reassigned.
- **Stay within your plot:** Keep all plants, objects and rocks inside your borders.
- **No garbage service:** Take trash home; plant compost may stay in your plot.
- **Fencing:** Natural colours only—no fluorescent materials. Annual plots must be cleared of fencing and objects at season's end.
- **Grass trimming:** We mow main garden areas, but you must trim the grass within 2 ft of your plot's edge.
- **Driving:** Only use driving paths marked on the map.
- **No pesticides or herbicides:** Only natural/organic products are permitted.
- **Respect your neighbours:** Be courteous and work to resolve small issues directly.
